Proceedings of the State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) Meeting to fix the Scale of Finance (SoF) for the year 2025-26 held on 7th April, 2025 at the Conference Hall, Manipur Secretariat (South Block), Imphal.

The State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) meeting to fix the Scale of Finance (SoF) for major crops and other agriculture related activities in the State along with the working capital requirement for Animal Husbandry and Fisheries farmers for the year 2025-26 was held on 7th April, 2025 at the Conference Hall, Manipur Secretariat (South Block), Imphal.

The meeting was chaired by Shri Arun Kumar Sinha, IAS, Principal Secretary (Agriculture), Govt. of Manipur.

List of participants is enclosed as Annexure-I.

At the outset of the meeting, Smt. Bidyarani Ayekpam (MCS), Managing Director, MSCB Ltd./Convener, SLTC welcomed all the participants and apprised the Committee that Administrative Secretary (Agriculture), Government of Manipur is chairing the meeting of State Level Technical Committee as per NABARD's circular dated 15.04.2020. The Committee was informed that all Line Departments concerned were requested to furnish their comments/ views with detailed calculations for major crops, other agriculture related activities and working capital requirement for Animal Husbandry and Fishery activities for the year 2025-26. It was further informed that the proposed Scale of Finance has been updated after incorporating the information received from the Departments and is being placed before the SLTC for consideration.

Shri Arun Kumar Sinha (IAS), Principal Secretary (Agriculture), Govt. of Manipur/Chairman, SLTC interacted with the members from Line Departments sharing his views and suggestions. He also expressed that there is a significant increase in the proposed Scale of Finance of crops due to enhancement of labour cost.

Shri Peter Salam (MCS), Director (Agriculture), Manipur informed that irrigation cost has been accounted for in the proposed Scale of Finance for Agricultural crops, wherever required apart from revising the labour cost.

Shri Bendang Aier, DGM, NABARD, Manipur Regional Office, Imphal expressed that component wise break-up cost of the items included in Scale of Finance should be provided by Line Departments and circulate to all stakeholders. He also suggested that Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Department should mention the breed of dairy animal whether it is local or crossbred while fixing the Scale of Finance. He further suggested rounding up the figures of Scale of Finance in a uniform manner.

After a detailed deliberation on the proposed Scale of Finance for the year 2025-26 and taking into consideration the inputs/comments/views from all concerned Stakeholders, it was decided as under:

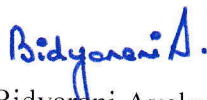
1. That the Scale of Finance for crops in respect of Agriculture Department for the year 2025-26 shall be adopted as proposed by the Agriculture Department.

2. That the Scale of Finance for crops in respect of Horticulture Department for the year 2025-26 along with the newly added items viz. Strawberry and Mushroom shall be adopted as proposed by the Horticulture Department.
3. That the Scale of Finance in respect of Fisheries Department for the year 2025-26 shall be adopted as proposed by the Fisheries Department.
4. That the Scale of Finance in respect of Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Department for the year 2025-26 shall be adopted as proposed by the Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Department.
5. That the component wise break-up with details calculation of all the crops/activities included in the Scale of Finance for the year 2025-26 shall be circulated to all Stakeholders for information and record at their end.

Details of the new Scale of Finance fixed for major crops and other activities in the State along with the working capital requirement for Animal Husbandry and Fisheries farmers for the year 2025-26 is enclosed as Annexure-II.

The meeting ended with thanks from the Chair.
